Position Description: We are looking for a minister to lead our campus outreach, focusing primarily on undergraduate students. This would involve overseeing discipleship and leadership training for students, leading and coordinating outreach activities and events, as well as participating in Sunday worship services at Incarnation Church. Currently, Incarnation's campus ministry is facilitated by the lead pastor and one volunteer. The goal would be for a campus minister to work with this team and eventually take over leadership of all campus related ministry.

Qualifications: Significant leadership experience with undergraduate students is required. While preference will be given to those who have experience as campus ministry staff, we are open to recent college graduates, provided they have had significant leadership experience during their time as a college student.

Candidate is responsible for fundraising their salary. Incarnation will provide significant leadership and fundraising training through Ministry Partner Development (MPD), as well as provide ongoing fundraising mentoring. In addition, a grant of up to \$8000 may be available to help fund the first year of ministry.

The position begins Summer 2021.
