

Seeds of Hope Children's Ministry positions

Seeds of Hope, a small Anglican church located in the East End of Pittsburgh, is looking to hire children's ministers. We are a small, passionate congregation, and children (ages 3-16) make up half of the weekly attendees. We are looking to train the children in leadership and participation in the life of the church.

We are looking for two teachers to take the lead; one for each age group; (3-5 year olds and 6-10 year olds). We anticipate a time for the children to learn and grow in the Lord, during the Sermon time at church. We are in transition as a church, as we seek a new Rector, and have been without a permanent rector the past year and half. We lost our children's ministry leader as she returned to her home country of Kenya last October.

PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Prep lessons each week (one lesson for 3-5 year olds; one lesson for 6-10 year olds). We are hoping to have curriculum to provide for you.
2. Prep craft if appropriate to the lesson per week.
3. Prep for a skit or reciting a memory verse to share during a Sunday service (approximately every other month).
4. Coordinate volunteers. We will have parents or older children sign up to volunteer each Sunday. This would be two volunteers each week. One for the younger kids (3-5) and one for the 6-10 age group.
5. Be available Sundays 9:45am-11:30am. Join us for church (10:00am) and then take the children downstairs for the Children's time during the sermon (approximately 30 minutes).
6. Coordinate lessons with a co-teacher.

Position requires 1-2 hours/week for preparation
